Phase I. (Establishment)

- Government proposes the Citizens' Assembly
- Parliament formally establishes the Citizens' Assembly and agrees its Terms of Reference

Phase II. (Operation)

- Chairperson appointed
- Members recruited
- Meetings held
- Recommendations agreed
- Report drafted

Phase III. (Reporting)

- Report submitted to Oireachtas
- Oireachtas Committee responds to recommendations
- Government responds to recommendations

FRENCH GREAT NATIONAL DEBATE

(January-March 2019)

- <u>Commissioning authority</u>: French Government
- <u>Topic/Remit</u>: 4 thematics (Ecological Transition, Public Spending and Taxation, Public Services and State Organisation, Democracy and Citizenship)
- <u>Governance</u>: Operational inter-ministry task force + 5 guarantors
- <u>Process</u>: Online platforme + « doleances books » + 10 000+ local townhall debates + 21 sortitioned-based « Regional Citizens' Conferences » (including 1 only for Youth, 18-25 years old)
- <u>Number of participants</u>: 1404 citizens randomly selected to participate in the Regional Citizens' Conferences (in total, 1,5 million people participate to the National Debate)
- Output: 230 recommendations on all 4 topics
- Political commitment: No clear political commitment
- Political impact: none
 - <u>Budget</u>: estimated at €12 million

FRENCH CITIZENS' CONVENTION ON CLIMATE

- <u>Commissioning authority</u>: The French President announced the Convention. Formally constituted by the Prime Minister, through an official mission letter to the Economic, Social and Environmental Council (ESEC)
- <u>Topic/Remit</u>: How can greenhouse gas emissions be reduced by at least 40% (compared to 1990 levels) by 2030 in a spirit of social justice?
- <u>Governance</u>: 15 representatives of government, think tanks, unions, business and experts in climate science, policy, and democracy + 2 citizens + 3 Guarantors
- Process: 7 face-to-face Week-ends + 1 online Week-end + 100 webinars (platform)
- Number of participants: 150 citizens, from 16 to 80 years old
- <u>Output</u>: 149 measures on 5 topics: Transport & mobility, consumption, housing, production and the workplace, nutrition endorsed by 95% of participants
- <u>Political commitment</u>: follow-up "without filter" to a referendum, a vote in parliament, or direct regulatory application.
- Political impact: four years later, 20% implemented in original form, 51% partially, 22% abandoned or still pending
 - <u>Budget</u>: estimated at €5.4 million






FRENCH CITIZENS' CONVENTION ON END OF LIFE

(December 2022 - Avril 2023)

- <u>Commissioning authority</u>: French government, hosted by the CESE
- <u>Topic/Remit</u>: Is the end of life support framework suitable to the different situations encountered, or should changes be made?
- <u>Governance</u>: Governance Committee, Steering Commitee and Guarantors
- <u>Process</u>: 9 Week-ends in Paris, 27 days in total + continous engagement on platform
- Number of participants: 185 citizens sortition based on 6 criteria
- <u>Output</u>: 65 recommandations, endorsed at 92%
- <u>Political commitment</u>: legislative proposal on assisted dying by summer 2023
- Political impact: pending
- <u>Budget</u>: estimated at €5 millions
