



## full-time equivalent employment rate, 2014




# Intersecting inequalities: mean monthly earnings in PPS, 2014




Gender gap in percentage (%)



# Intersecting inequalities: Graduates of tertiary education (2014)




# Intersecting inequalities: People doing cooking and housework every day one hour or more











# Social protection measures act as an important means for achieving higher gender equality




