You are in receipt of this template for the purposes of providing a case study for possible inclusion in the “Ten years of the UNECE Strategy for Education for Sustainable Development” publication.

The deadline for submission is August 15, 2015.

In order for your submission to be considered, the project/programme described in the case study must have taken place or, is currently on-going in the UNECE region and address one of the following issues:

1. Supports the promotion of ESD through policy, regulatory and operational frameworks
2. Promotes sustainable development through formal, non-formal and informal learning
3. Equips educators with the competence to include sustainable development in their teaching
4. Develops ESD tools and materials
5. Promotes research on and development of ESD
6. Strengthens cooperation on ESD at all levels within the ECE region
7. Fosters conservation, use and promotion of knowledge of indigenous peoples, as well as local and traditional knowledge, in ESD
8. Promotes whole institution approaches and/or ESD school plans
9. Encourages ESD into teacher education
10. Strengthens TVET in support of sustainable development and the transition to a green economy

The narrative of the case study must address the statements outlined below and have a maximum length of 1000 words. The narrative should tell the “story” of the case and not a set of bullets (i.e. it should be submitted in the form of an article).

The case study (i.e. article) should address the following:

1. Background/context
2. Location
3. Goal/objective of the initiative
4. Target audience/leaders
5. Resources
6. Key leverage points
7. Challenges
8. Accomplishments/evaluation and results including unusual or unexpected outcomes
